# POLICY

The College shall assure the provision of career counseling to enrolled students that leads to informed participation in the national matching programs for graduate medical education.

# **RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL(S):**

Office of Student Affairs, Office of Clinical Education, Career Counselor

# **PROCEDURES:**

- 1. The Office of Student Affairs shall create and implement a comprehensive and progressive curriculum that provides group and individualized residency counseling through all four years of the degree program.
- 2. The Offices of Student Affairs and Clinical Education work in cooperation to assist students in their preparation for residency application and interviews.
- 3. The Office of Student Affairs shall provide periodic reports to the College Executive Committee regarding outcomes of the career counseling curriculum and recommendations for improvement.
- 4. The Office of Student Affairs shall provide such additional career counseling as may be needed to students who will be unable to complete the degree program or enter a graduate medical education program.
- 5. The annual student survey shall provide feedback regarding services related to career counseling and inform continuous quality improvement.
