POLICY

BCOM shall adopt a mission that is consistent with the delivery of osteopathic medical education and reflects the goals and objectives of its academic programs. The mission statement shall be subject to periodic review and reaffirmation of continued relevance upon counsel with faculty and students.

RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL(S):

Board of Trustees

PROCEDURE:

- 1. BCOM shall conduct periodic strategic planning to identify tactical initiatives for its mission-centric areas. This process shall assure alignment of the College's mission with its guiding principles and programmatic objectives.
- 2. BCOM shall use the strategic planning process to state its mission and promote faculty and student dialogue to attain consensus and affirmation.
- 3. The BCOM Dean shall transmit any proposed modifications to the mission or the Mission Statement to the President and the BCOM Board of Trustees who shall solely determine final approval and adoption.
- 4. BCOM shall assure campus-wide distribution of the Mission Statement and any associated statements of vision and values along with the College's tactical initiatives.
- 5. BCOM shall report progress in meeting its tactical initiatives at least semi-annually and reaffirm its mission and strategies annually.
