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POLICY

The College shall provide a feasible, comparable learning experience for any student who, for health-related reasons, is unable to participate in activities required by the curriculum due to a risk of exposure to hazardous chemicals or materials in the special environment.

RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL(S):

Office of Student Affairs

PROCEDURES:

1. A student must make a formal request through the Office of Student Affairs to participate in a comparable learning experience if the special environment participation is a significant element of the curriculum.
2. The Office of Student Affairs shall maintain operating procedures for any such requests for pertaining to special environments.
