

# Suggestive Instructions for CV Template

(These CV instructions are NOT mandatory and therefore will not influence your portfolio)

1. The rationale for using a standardized CV template for the promotion dossier is to promote an equitable process of presenting and evaluating accomplishments by candidates. The purpose is not to enforce specific formatting requirements such as **bold typeface** or underlining section headings. The purpose is rather to provide guidance on what information should be included in the CV.
2. For all sections in the CV, it is suggested to list items in the order from most-current to least-current.
3. The numeric scores of teaching evaluations for teaching at BCOM should be included for all evaluated teaching sessions. However, teaching evaluations for teaching at other institutions are not required (but may be included if the candidate chooses to do so).
4. Some items listed in the CV template may not apply to everyone. Such items can simply be deleted. There is no need to say "not applicable". However, we caution against not including information that may be reasonably believed to be available (such as teaching evaluations at BCOM).
5. It is acceptable to add subheadings for items that do not seem to fit in any heading of the CV template.
