- Main campus located in Las Cruces, NM.
- Matriculated first class in 2016.
- 430 new physician graduates (2020, 2021, 2022.)
- 99% Graduate Medical Education (GME) placement.
- Number two in the nation for percentage of underrepresented minority students (URM) enrolled in colleges of osteopathic medicine.
(AACOMAS Applicants & Matriculants by Race and Ethnicity by COM, 2018-2021.)
- Recipient of the 2022 Health Professions Higher Education Excellence in Diversity (HEED) Award from INSIGHT Into Diversity. One of only six osteopathic medical schools to receive this award.

BURRELL FLORIDA EXPANSION

- Affiliated with Florida Tech.
- New four-year campus at Florida Tech (100 students proposed for 2024.)
- Currently, 34 third-year and fourth-year students in Florida for clinical rotations.
- Currently, 25 graduates in Florida GME training programs.
- 13 clinical affiliations in Florida's Space Coast (hospitals and clinics) and growing.
- Currently, 80 appointed Space Coast, FL Clinical Faculty and growing.



FLORIDA **STATE BENEFITS**

RETAIN FLORIDA MEDICAL STUDENTS

Per 2021 AACOM Matriculation Report, and due to limited seats, 439 (62 percent) Floridians were admitted into an out-of-state osteopathic medical school.

DIVERSIFY FLORIDA'S PHYSICIAN WORKFORCE

Burrell College ranks number two in the nation among all osteopathic medical schools for percentage of underrepresented minority students.

RETAIN FLORIDA MEDICAL SCHOOL GRADUATES

Per AAMC 2021 Workforce Report:

- 47.4 percent of Florida-based medical school graduates practiced medicine in Florida.
- 78.8 percent of physicians who completed both medical school and residency in Florida remained in the state to practice.

The average physician practice supports 17.07 jobs in the economy, including their own

(Birthplace of America's Missile & Space Activity)

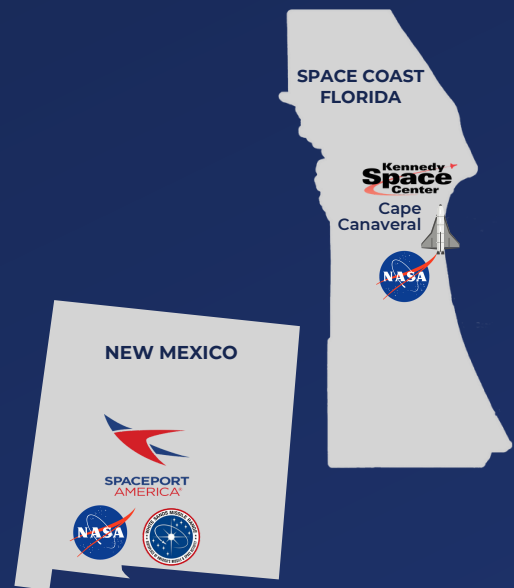
