## Student Organization Event Alcohol Attestation

Regarding the availability of alcohol at chartered student organization events, if the event is approved, the host organization will abide by the following:

- Students may not consume or be in possession of alcoholic beverages on the College campus (per the student handbook).
- Student organizations may request the availability of alcohol at an off-campus student event. The Office of Student Affairs will review all requests and provide the determination.
- Members of the Burrell community in attendance at an off-campus student event as representatives of the school and the field of medicine, will abide by the Code of Professional Conduct, Student Handbook, local laws, etc.
- Abide by the Bylaws of the Student Government Association, which governs the appropriate use of club funds.
- Ensure that publicity for the event will not advertise the availability of alcoholic beverages.
- Ensure that a representative of the hosting organization will be present at all times during the function.
- Make reasonable efforts to ensure that alcoholic beverages will not be consumed by individuals under 21 years of age.
- Make reasonable efforts to ensure that non-alcoholic beverages will be available in sufficient quantities.
- Limit attendance of the event to members of the campus community and their guests. The term "guest" does not imply the general public.
- Have a plan for the transportation of impaired guests. Options include: designating group members who will provide transportation; calling a taxi; encouraging individuals to schedule via ride share app (e.g., Uber, Lyft, etc.); prearranging transportation to and from your event through a local business
