Additionally, I am responsible for researching and understanding my specific entitlements including that:
Eligibility is based on service after September 2001, and results in variable payment percentages, which will apply to tuition and fees, basic allowance for housing (BAH), and books and supplies. Books and supplies stipend is limited to a maximum of \$1000 per year but payment depends on how many credits for which the student is enrolled.
Active duty members, anyone training at 1/2 time or less, and those pursuing training solely by distance learning are not eligible for basic allowance for housing (BAH).
Active Duty members are not eligible for books and supplies.
Any overpayment incurred by the student veteran is the veteran's responsibility and not the responsibility of Burrell COM.
