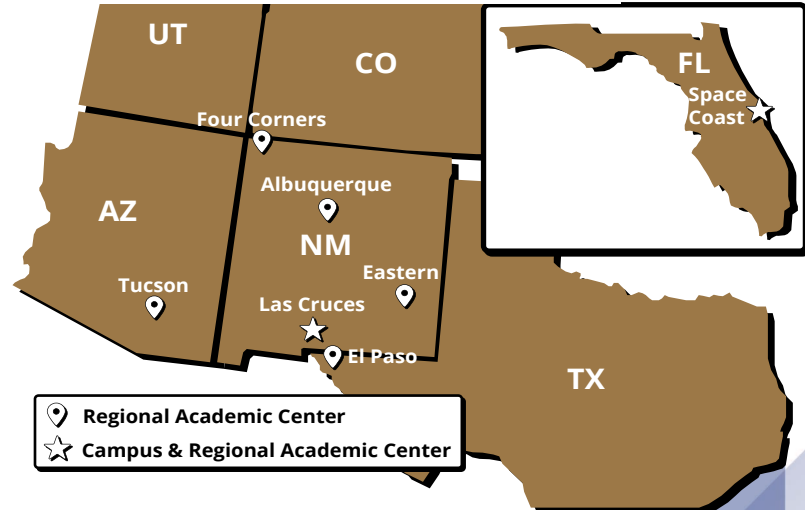


Pre-Clinical Education

We utilize active learning techniques through case discussions, team-based learning, laboratory and skills instruction, and interactive integrative sessions. This includes participating in simulated clinical experiences, small group sessions and directed study. Highlights of the pre-clinical curriculum include:

- Mission Medicine:** Engage in a community-based learning curriculum
- Gross Anatomy Laboratory:** Participate in cadaveric dissection to maximize your understanding of the fundamentals of anatomy
- Principles of Clinical Practice:** Develop foundational clinical skills for treating patients
